System and Security - Find security updates, check your computer's current security status. Discover any pressing security issues.

Programs - Access your programs. Uninstall previously installed programs or modify Windows 7 startup options.

User Accounts and Family Safety - Set parental controls, and add or remove users from Windows 7.

Appearance and Personalization - Customize your desktop background, colors and screen resolution settings.

Clock, Language and Region - Modify input methods and update the clock.

Ease of Access - Set options for optimizing the visual display and make the screen easier for you to view.
